



INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY HUB: Geospatial analysis, cybersecurity, data centers and a statewide communication infrastructure with global connectivity allows Missouri to store, protect and distribute the world's data.

UNIQUE UNDERGROUND FACILITIES: Missouri has more than 30 million square-feet of stable and unique underground natural environments giving companies a safe and secure place to store your data.

SMART INCENTIVES: Data centers may be eligible to receive exemptions from sales taxes on utilities, machinery, equipment, computers, and construction materials for a new or expanded facility for up to 10-15 years.

HIGHLY RANKED CITIES: Kansas City and St. Louis are both ranked as top cities for tech jobs.

A TREND LEADER: Kansas City was chosen by Google Fiber as its first location, and gigabit service is available across the state due to our extensive fiber networks.

DELIVERING TALENT: Organizations like LaunchCode and Claim Academy are delivering IT talent at an accelerated rate for Missouri employers. In Missouri you pay less for talent, and benefit from the presence of a strong cluster of IT firms, fiber, suppliers and educators throughout the state.



EXPANDING BROADBAND INFRASTRUCTURE:

Missouri is expanding economic opportunity through investments in broadband infrastructure. This includes dedicated resources to expand high speed internet to unserved areas of the state. In 2020, Missouri invested more than \$555 million in federal, state and private subsidies, loans and grants to connect high-speed internet to 227,500 locations throughout the state.
