MISSOURI'S MANUFACTURING INDUSTRY

WORLD LEADER: Missouri is a world leader in aerospace and automotive manufacturing and exports \$15.6 billion in manufacturing products to 196 countries every year.

QUALITY WORKFORCE: Missouri has nearly 8,000 manufacturing establishments employing more than 290,000 in manufacturing, making up 10% of the state's total employment.

FAVORABLE ENVIRONMENT: Since 2010, more than \$4 billion has been invested in Missouri automotive facilities, and the state has supported this growth with strategic incentive programs.

CENTRAL LOCATION: Missouri's central location provides efficient access to both coasts, as well as international markets. Kansas City has direct Class 1 rail service to parts suppliers in Mexico.

CENTER FOR EXCELLENCE: Missouri produced more than 678,000 vehicles from Ford and GM in 2023, and today more than 16,000 of Missouri's highly-trained workforce builds advanced military jets at Boeing's facilities.
