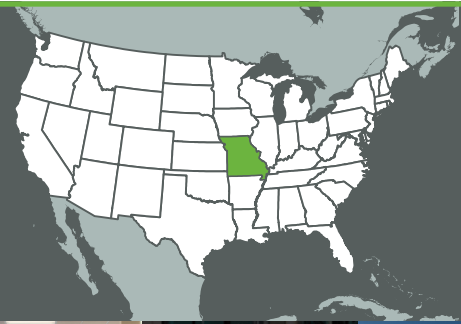

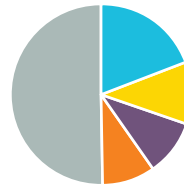
Missouri's exports to China in 2018: \$782,829,971¹

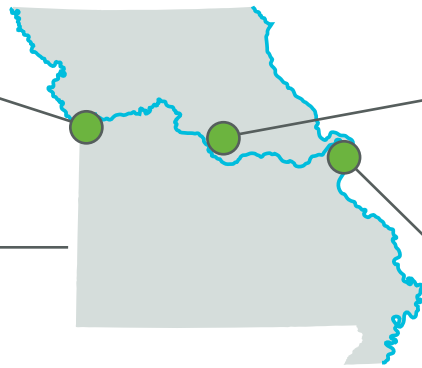
